DIRECTIONS FROM MACCLESFIELD

From Macclesfield take the A523 towards Leek.

After approximately 7 miles you will enter the village of Rushton Spencer. The second pub on your left is the Royal Oak. At this point the main road (A523) bears round to the right, instead, take the road which goes up the hill straight ahead signed Meerbrook.

Immediately at the top of the hill, turn left at the white railings signed Meerbrook.

Continue up the hill, passed a small holding called Fir Trees Farm, then round a right hand bend go passed Heaton House Farm (on the left) and follow the Country Fayre and Farm Fun Day signs.

DIRECTIONS FROM LEEK

From Leek take the A523 towards Macclesfield. Approx 3 miles out of Leek there is a large green sign post just prior to a left hand bend with a road off to the right. Take the right hand fork which is Leek Old Road and
